Exceptional Pass was discovered (or conceptualized or something) less than fifty years ago. The supernatural history and creative anthropology of the area was the focus of much scholarly speculation and artistic achievement in the late twentieth century. Although this was all showcased in four exhibitions at the Whyte Museum of the Canadian Rockies, there was widespread fear that Exceptional Pass had vanished once again into the mountain mists following the death of Canadian poet Jon Whyte, one of the original explorers.

Turns out, Exceptional Pass was there all along, in a parallel but perpendicular universe. And it's back in the news following the dramatic events outlined in this graphic novel.
