The beleaguered communications director at Sir Richard Middling University is struggling to do the right thing while navigating the quirks and minefields of campus politics. The challenges soon pile up: a takeover bid by an upstart polytechnical college, a protest against a bigoted guest speaker, and a campaign to tear down a statue of the university's controversial namesake.
