

Three *scarecrows* (regulatory bodies) have gone amok. One aims to “kill the messenger”, another to “protect their image” at the risk of the environment, and the last one’s shingle reads “Have a pen, will lie.”

Cowpies and Lies is a humorous **satire**—a sequel to the saga *Scarecrows and Stupidity* by D.R. Cameron.

The protagonist, BruceG, and the growers revolt against the new Environmental Act by tossing a few builders and politicians overboard at the epic Tea Party.

Follow the builder *Inquisition* as they attempt to butcher evidence to deny *systemic discrimination*.

Dysfunctionality reigns supreme when the growers pass “bad bylaws” rejected by Blind Justice.

Agitated, they shout, “Kill the pig, kill the pig,” and hire a lawyer who uses the ancient Greek art of *sophism* (deceit) to attack BruceG.

The *Achilles heel* of prosecutors is exposed when the *Complaint Ogre* rules that “bylaw incompetence” is reasonable.

D.R. Cameron has followed *scarecrows* for over 40 years and is very familiar with their antics of deceit, lying, cover-up, face-saving, and stupidity.
