Erin Bow is an award-winning poet and novelist, whose honours include the TD Canadian Children's Literature Award, the Governor General's Award for young people's literature, and the CBC Literary Award for poetry. She's published three volumes of poetry and six novels for young readers, the most famous of which are probably *Plain Kate* and *The Scorpion Rules*. The most recent, *Simon Sort of Says*, was recently longlisted for the National Book Award in the United States. Among the highlights of Erin's literary life are ghostwriting for Stephen Hawking, opening for Margaret Atwood, and living in Mongolia while working on *Stand on the Sky*.
